
Virginia will demonstrate a variety of mixed media techniques, including "having fun with yupo". Learn how to revive and add excitement to those watercolours you filed away!

### GALLERY OPEN EVERY SATUDAY. August at the MTAS Gallery, Musson Lane.



# CASS REPORT

The CASS Executive and Society Delegates have met to discuss the future of CASS events - in particular, the Art of Sydney, to which MTAS has had a strong showing. The Art of Sydney for 2021 will be the 31st year of the event - but it will be different. To ensure money is well-spent, sufficient people would be available and willing to help and, importantly, attend an exhibition and buy art, we are faced with too many uncertainties.

The Art of Sydney will be moving online for 2021! Artists will be able to register and pay online and upload images of their work. To help those images present the best they can - the exhibition will still be judged and prizes awarded - MTAS will arrange an 'image ready' photo activity to help you with your artwork images.

There will be some changes to the categories and the Terms and Conditions but I expect to see a return of the 9" x 5" category, sizes in other sections, apart from Miniatures, will be unrestricted (but think about postage and delivery of sold works) and I expect there will be allowance for unframed works as well.
